The responses to the recent user group survey identified affordability of Gorman Arts Centre facilities post upgrades as a key issue. artsACT will continue to engage with Arts Capital as it develops its pricing policy particularly when the scope of the refurbishment works is known. The ACT Government provides funding to Arts Capital to operate Ainslie and Gorman Arts Centres and for the venues to be accessible and affordable to the arts sector.
